Who will Work With My Child?

C.P.C. is staffed by a team of highly trained, supervised, and experienced mental health professionals.

A Master's or Doctorate degreed **Behavioral Specialist Consultant (BSC)**, develops an appropriate behavior intervention plan, and consults with family, school and other service agencies regarding implementation of the behavior plan.

An **Autism Specialist** oversees the development and implementation of the treatment plan for children within the autistic spectrum.

A Master's degreed **Mobile Therapist (MT)**, and **Outpatient Therapist** provide individual and family therapy, and assess the child and family's needs, concerns, and response to treatment.

A Bachelor's degreed **Therapeutic Staff Support (TSS)**, implements the behavior intervention plan, and models and teaches appropriate problem-solving and social skills to the child and family.
